

RESOLUTION NO. 17-021

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HELOTES, TEXAS SUPPORTING THE WIDENING OF F.M. 1560 BETWEEN ITS INTERSECTION WITH GALM AND SHAENFIELD ROADS AND S.H. 16; AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY STEPS TO IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS RESOLUTION; INCORPORATING RECITALS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to lessen vehicular congestion, increase the movement of goods and people, and improve existing connectivity within the F.M. 1560 corridor; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) proposes to widen F.M. 1560 between its intersection with Galm and Shaenfield Roads and S.H. 16; and

WHEREAS, the City of Helotes recognizes that proposed road improvements will accomplish the goals of improving vehicular safety, efficiency, traffic congestion within the F.M. 1560 corridor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HELOTES, TEXAS THAT:

Section One. Support. The City of Helotes supports widening F.M. 1560 between its intersection with Galm and Shaenfield Roads and S.H. 16. The project includes the expansion of F.M. 1560 from two (2) to four (4) lanes, including turn lanes, bike accommodations, and sidewalks.


Section Two. Project Development. The City of Helotes requests that the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) initiate any and all activities necessary for the completion of the proposed improvements to F.M. 1560.

Section Three. Authorization. The City Administrator is hereby authorized to take all necessary steps to implement the provisions of this Resolution

Section Four. Recitals. The City Council finds all of the above recitals to be true and correct and incorporates the same in this Resolution as findings of fact.

Section Five. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Resolution is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or illegal, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections of this Resolution. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed this Resolution, and each section, subsection, clause, or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, or phrases be declared void.
