Memo to: C6 Residential Customers in the City of Helotes, Texas

Re: 2020 Spring Brush Pick-up Rescheduled for June 15<sup>th</sup> to July 31<sup>st</sup>

On March 30, 2020, we announced the cancellation of the 2020 Spring brush pick-up. The decision to cancel was based primarily upon the information we had at that time on the spread of the COVID-19 virus. Several of our staff members and I were attending daily briefings by County, State, and Federal agencies and at that time, all indications were that the number of positive COVID-19 cases and deaths were increasing and were expected to continue to do so exponentially. We were concerned about the possibility that our solid waste hauler, C6 Disposal Services, Inc. (C6), as well as the two primary brush repositories could be negatively impacted by the virus resulting in the loss of employees by self-quarantine requirements or the repositories closing for the same reason. This, then, would have left us with the distinct possibility of having large brush piles remaining for the long term.

Since the time we announced the cancellation of the brush pick-up, we have been working with C6 to find other options or alternative ways to complete the work. Now, with the dramatic reduction of positive cases across Texas, Governor Abbott has implemented his program to "Open Texas" as a first step in opening businesses and allowing Texans to get back to normalcy.

The past 60 days have enabled us to continually monitor the decreasing trends in the spread of the COVID-19 virus and, as a result, we are rescheduling the 2020 Spring brush pick-up to begin on **Monday, June 15th and end on Friday, July 31st**.
