

RESOLUTION NO. 17-003

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HELOTES, TEXAS SUPPORTING THE SUPERSTREET CONCEPT FOR S.H. 16 (BANDERA RD.) FROM, GENERALLY, LOOP 1604 TO TRIANA PARKWAY; AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY STEPS TO IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS RESOLUTION; INCORPORATING RECITALS; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

WHEREAS, City of Helotes City Council desires to provide effective solutions to increase movement of goods and people through the S.H. 16 corridor, as well as solutions that improve upon existing connectivity; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) proposes to apply the Superstreet Concept on S.H. 16 from, generally, Loop 1604 to Triana Parkway, as highlighted within a 20-year traffic projections study and an open house dated August 14, 2014 at City Hall; and

WHEREAS, the City of Helotes recognizes that the Superstreet Concept accomplishes the goal of improving intersection safety and efficiency and will help alleviate heavy traffic congestion along the S.H. 16 corridor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HELOTES, TEXAS THAT:

Section One. Support. The City Council of the City of Helotes supports the S.H. 16 Superstreet Concept from, generally, Loop 1604 to Triana Parkway.


Section Two. Project Development. The City Council of the City of Helotes requests that the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) conduct the necessary project development activities for the proposed improvements to S.H. 16.

Section Three. Authorization. The City Administrator is hereby authorized to take all necessary steps to implement the provisions of this Resolution

Section Four. Recitals. The City Council finds all of the above recitals to be true and correct and incorporates the same in this Resolution as findings of fact.

Section Five. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Resolution is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or illegal, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections of this Resolution. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed this Resolution, and each section, subsection, clause, or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, or phrases be declared void.
