Discussion of and action on the appointment of Robert Hoeppner to the City of Helotes Ethics Commission, Place Seven, with a term expiring May 2023. (Mayor Whitehead)

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

On July 8, 2021, City Council adopted Ordinance No. 21-10, establishing clear requirements for a sworn ethics complaint and identifying the role of the Ethics Commission. The ordinance specifically identifies that the Ethics Commission is an advisory board to the City Council. The Commission consists of seven members, and each City Council Member shall appoint one member, and the Mayor shall appoint two members. All appointees are subject to the approval by a majority vote of City Council. Commission members shall serve concurrently with the corresponding council member's term. No member can serve more than two terms.

On August 12, 2021, the nominees for Place 1 through 6 were unanimously approved, with the exception of the nominee for Place 7 (the Mayor's second candidate). The nominee for Place 7 is a volunteer firefighter for the city and in accordance with the ordinance, a volunteer firefighter is defined as an official (appointed), making such ineligible to serve on the Ethics Commission.

Another nominee to fill Place 7 is now being presented for consideration. Qualifications to be on the Ethics Commission are:

1. Members must be registered voters who reside in the corporate limits of the City or its Extra-Territorial Jurisdiction (ETJ). No more than three members can be ETJ residents; and

2. Members can not be:

- A City of Helotes official or spouse of a City of Helotes official;
- A City of Helotes employee or spouse of a City of Helotes employee;
- An elected public official;
- A candidate for elected public office;

- An officer of a political party;
- A campaign treasurer, campaign manager, officer, or other policy or decision-maker for any political action committee;
- A member of any board/commission for which the position is appointed by council;
- A lobbyist;
- Anyone having any substantial interests with any city officer;
- Anyone who has been a paid campaign worker or paid political consultant for any city council or mayoral candidate;
- Any person contracted with the city or any person who is employed by a business entity that is contracted with the city; or
- A convicted felon.
